FEET WASHING

John 13:1-17

"If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet: ye also OUGHT to wash one another's feet. For I have given you an example" (John 13:14-15).

(WAS NOT A JEWISH CUSTOM)

In the custom each washed his own feet (Genesis 18:4, 19:2). In the ordinance we are taught to wash one another's feet (John 13:14). An ordinance exemplifying submission to our brother. "Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God" (Ephesians 5:21).

JESUS PRAYED FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY

Jesus Built but One Church:

"I will build MY CHURCH" (Matthew 16:18).

Bible Condemns Division Among Christians:

"Now I beseech you . . . that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you" (1 Corinthians 1:10).

Bible Calls Christians to the One Fold (Church): "That they all may be one as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe" (John 17:21). "Other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and "they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, and one shepherd" (John 10:16).

"Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate . . ." (2 Corinthians 6:17). "Come out of her [Babylon], my people" (Revelation 18:4). Read 2 Corinthians 6:14-18.
