

There Is a Way Which Seemeth Right

I have, and I am sure you have also. The mistakes of our natural lives many times can be changed for the better, but when it comes to the caring of our souls, we must not make mistakes.

Proverbs 14:12 says, "There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death." An unsaved person cannot make right decisions when it comes to eternal things, for they are void of the Holy Spirit, the one who directs us into all truth. John 16:13 tells us, "Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth."

The Bible says in Galatians 6:7, "Whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap." We need to be very careful what we do; just because it seems right from a fleshly viewpoint.

Many today are joining some church or denomination just because it seems to be the right thing to do. No where in God's Word does it tell us to join any religious organization, but rather we are to be joined up with Jesus Christ. John 3:3 says,

"Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God," and verse 7 says, "Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again." In John 14:6 Jesus proclaimed, "I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me."

No friend, we are not saved that way either for the Bible says it is the blood of Jesus Christ that cleanseth us from all sin (1 John 1:7).
